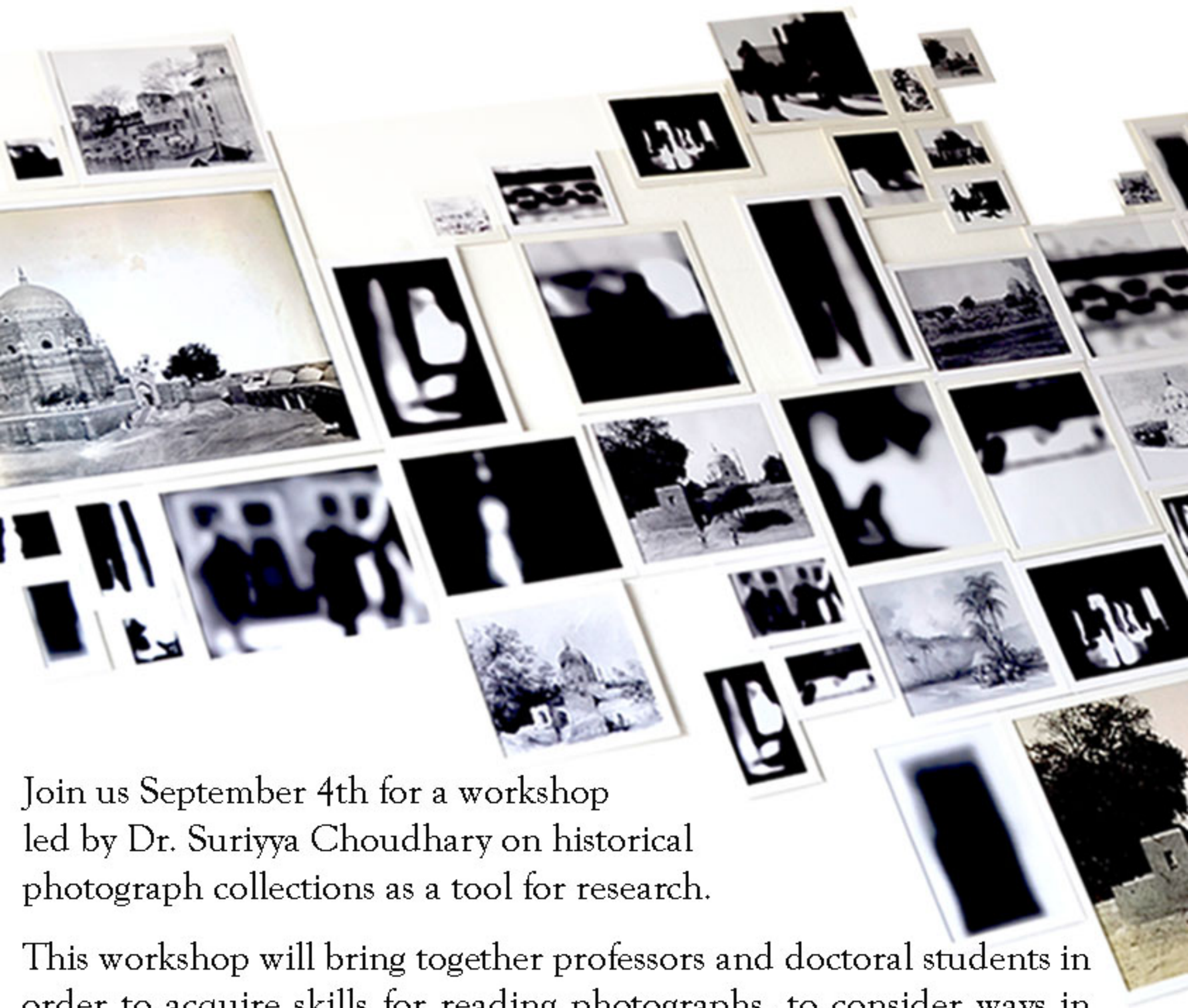


# CAPTURING CULTURE
