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Mongols in China and their Dialect Characteristics

There are approximately **6 million** people classified as **ethnic Mongols living in China**. Most of them live in Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region.

Mongols in China still retain their own language and culture; the **cultural and linguistic unity** of the Mongols has never been broken. However, due to differences in the area of residence, Mongolians in each region are **different regarding their dialects and lifestyles**.

This presentation will summarize the basic features of Inner Mongolia dialects, and compare them with the linguistic features of the ***Secret History of the Mongols***, which is the largest surviving text of Middle Mongolian, and then also explore the characteristics of middle Mongolian retained by Inner Mongolia dialects.
