## Altaic people in Buryatia

**Buryatia** is the home place of the Buryat people whose language belongs to the Mongolic language family. Besides Buryats, other **Altaic peoples** inhabit Buryatia, namely the **Soyots**, who speak a Sayan Turkic language, three different **Ewenki** groups (Barguzin, North-Baikal and Baunt) whose languages belong to Northern Tungusic, and the Onon **Khamnigan** Mongol people whose language displays several archaic Mongolic features. Except of Buryat, all the aforementioned Altaic varieties are **highly endangered languages**.

A strong **assimilation** process to Buryat has occurred, with respect to both language and culture. For instance, they follow the Mongolian style of cattle breeding. Some speakers, however, still preserve their **linguistic identity**, and thus are **trilingual**, i.e. they master their native language, Buryat and Russian.

This presentation will give an overview of the Altaic peoples residing in Buryatia, focusing on sociolinguistic aspects, historical facts, common and diverging cultural features as well as their relation with Mongolia and its peoples. Moreover, this presentation will reveal who were the native inhabitants of Buryatia.
